Note that we recommend co-requisite and pre-requisite courses, so that you can follow the related courses easily. However, this is **not a compulsory directive**.

MTE 01 is pre-requisite for MTE 07 to MTE 10.

MTE 07 is a pre-requisite for MTE 11.

MTE 07 is a co-requisite for MTE 08.

MTE 08 is a pre-requisite for MTE 14.

CHE 01 is a pre-requisite for CHE 04, CHE 05 and CHE10.

CHE 01 is a co-requisite for CHE 02.

CHE 02 is a pre-requisite for CHE 10.

CHE 04 is a pre-requisite for CHE 09.

CHE 05 is a co-requisite for CHE 06 and pre-requisite for CHE 09 and CHE 10.

PHE 02 is a pre-requisite for PHE 09.

PHE 10 is a co-requisite for PHE 16.

PHE 04 and PHE 05 are pre-requisites for PHE 14.

Since the Chemistry courses of IGNOU include quantitative techniques, we suggest that you take MTE 03, if you haven't studied Mathematics up to the +2 level. It will help you to cope better with these courses. However, **if you plan to take any other Mathematics electives (MTE 01, 02, 04 to 14), you are not permitted to take MTE 03.**

**While doing so, remember that the combination of courses should be such that in any discipline you choose to study, you take at least 4 credits at a time. Therefore, opt two 2-credit courses from the same discipline.**
